

BID AWARDING MEETING – MAY 14, 2008

The meeting was called to order by John Schaefer- Member.

This meeting was held to award the bid on the purchase of fourteen (14) 2008 Ford Crown Victoria Police Interceptor 4dr Sedans and one (1) 2008 Ford Crown Victoria 4dr Sedan LX P74 for the Michigan City Police Department.

Asst. Chief John Kintzele, M.C.P.D., addressed the Board with regards to the bid received from Don Hadley, Lake Shore Ford Mercury Toyota, Burns Harbor, IN; and the Q.P.A.

There was discussion among Asst. Chief Kintzele, Asst. Chief Swistek, Mayor Oberlie, Mr. Cate Mr. Schaefer and Attorney Espar.
