A swimmers will be issued an USS card with an ID number on it and is a must if the swimmer is to compete.

Gold Swimmers	3:30 pm – 5:30 pm (pick up time 5:45 pm)
Blue Swimmers	3:30 pm – 5:00 pm (pick up time 5:15 pm)
Red Swimmers	3:30 pm – 4:15 pm (pick up time 4:30 pm)

Locker room opens at 3:15 pm. Swimmers should be showered and on deck by 3:30 pm.
(Practice times to change to morning hours when school dismisses for summer)

Learn To Swim Program is Monday, Wednesday and Friday, 5:30 pm – 6:15 pm.

- Red Swimmers are the swimmers that are brand new to the team or just graduated from our Learn to Swim Program.
- Blue Swimmers are those swimmers that are more advanced than Red Swimmers but are not able to achieve the same workout level as Gold swimmers.
- Gold Swimmers are the most advanced swimmers as determined by the coach.
- If at all possible, all swimmers should have their suits on upon arrival to keep locker room time to a minimum.
- Each swimmer must rinse off in the shower prior to entering the pool.
- There is no food or drinks allowed on deck or in the stands. Swimmers may bring water bottles to use during practices.
- As stated in Indiana Swimming Regulations, the pool deck is for swimmers and registered coaches ONLY. Parents are welcome to sit in the stands. However, parents, please do not coach your swimmer from the stands. If you need to speak with your swimmer, please let one of the coaches know and they will send your child to you. If the coach feels it is necessary for the swimmer's best interest, a parent may be asked to wait outside. Occasionally a child has a hard time focusing when parents are present.
- COACHES ARE NOT AVAILABLE FOR QUESTIONS DURING PRACTICE TIMES. However, you may reach Coach Kim at 219-395-8130 (local call) after 7:00 pm.
- ALL team swimmers must wear goggles.
- When school is closed due to weather there is no practice.
- All swimmers are expected to participate in all dual competitions (a dual is Piranhas vs. Another Team.) Each month we also try to attend at least one local invitational as a "team" (an invitational is a competition involving 5-20 teams.) A schedule of all competitions and practices will be sent home by the end of April.
