

WASHINGTON PARK DOG BEACH – MICHIGAN CITY, INDIANA



Hours of operation – daily from dawn until dusk

Entrance to dog beach will be from Fedder's Alley parking lot using the east public access beach path. The dog beach is 400' wide by 50' deep or 20,000 square feet.

■ Signs will be placed at the east and west beach boundaries "NO DOGS BEYOND THIS POINT."

▲ Pet waste stations and rule signs will be posted on each end of the public access path.



### WASHINGTON PARK DOG BEACH RULES

- Hours of operation dawn to dusk
- Dogs must have current vaccinations
- Dogs must be leashed and be in owners control at all times. Leashes may not be longer than 6' in length
- Use park and beach at your own risk
- Dog owners are legally responsible for the behavior of their dog(s) at all times
- Dog Waste must be cleaned up by their owners immediately
- No aggressive dogs, sick dogs, dogs in heat, or dogs under 4 months old permitted
- Any bite of a person or other dog must be immediately reported to 911 Emergency Services and the parties involved must wait for an officer to respond except in the case where immediate medical care is necessary
